If your child attends Learning Support for lessons, their examinations will be carried out in a separate room(s).

A calculator will be required for the Science and selected Mathematics examinations please make sure your child is equipped, they will also need a black pen, pencil, ruler, mathematical equipment. These should all be kept in a clear plastic pencil case. We are not able to lend everyone equipment and this could mean your child may lose marks if they do not have the correct equipment.

Please note that **all** examinations will start in the hall, drama or learning support classrooms at the time shown on your child's timetable.

It is your child's responsibility to ensure they arrive promptly to the start of the examinations. Late arrival could mean they might not be allowed entry into the examinations hall. This will also have an impact on their breaks and lunch because a late start will mean a late finish before being dismissed.
