YOU NEED TO 'WISE UP' You are missing so much time from the academy that it will be difficult for youto keep in touch with lessons or work. 	 Stamp from tutor for every full week. Below 85% - meeting with Pastoral Year Lead, Education Welfare Officer and parent. Absences <u>will not be</u> authorised without a medical note. Aim for Bronze.
WISE UP!	 Your attendance is below 80% You need to 'WISE UP' and TAKE ACTION NOW! You are missing so much time from the academy that it will be almost impossible for you to keep in touch with lessons or work! 	 Aim for purple. The Local Authority will be informed. Education Welfare Officer will start formal action against your parents, unless you have a medical note or condition. This could result in a maximum of £2.500 fine or 3 months in prison.
